

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
COMMUNITY ARTS COUNCIL OF LINCOLN

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Nebraska Non Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following as the Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

I.

The name of the corporation shall be Community Arts Council of Lincoln.

II.

The period of duration shall be perpetual.

III.

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to encourage and promote the artistic and cultural life of the Lincoln community and its surrounding area. The corporation shall be operated exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes, and no part of the net earnings shall inure to the private shareholder or individual, and no substantial part of the activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. Upon dissolution of the corporation, all funds shall be distributed in accordance with the purposes above set forth.
